Summary

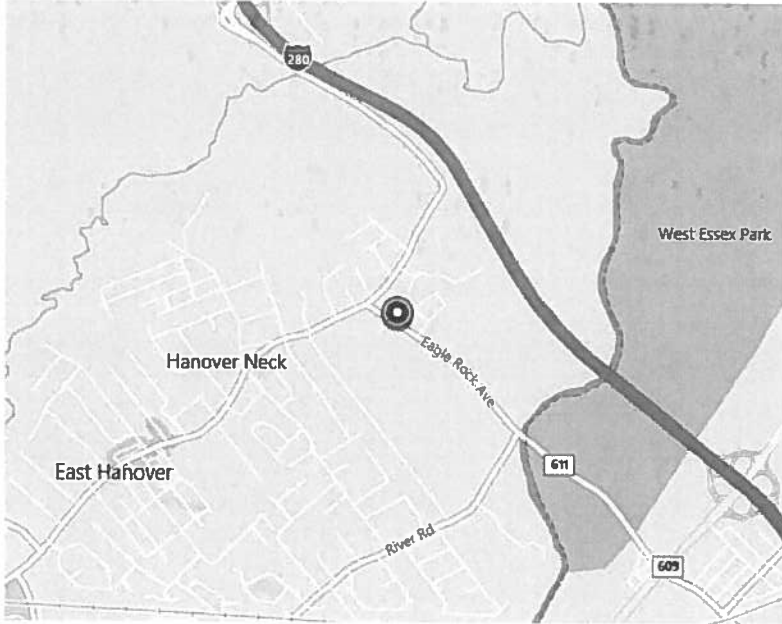
