

46th World Continuous Auditing & Reporting Symposium

Overview

The Symposium aims to bring together the public interested in knowing the state of the art of research on trends in auditing and continuous monitoring involving emerging technologies, such as blockchain, big data and analytics, machine learning, artificial intelligence, XBRL, IoT, among others.

The event, which will take place between June 6 and 7, 2019 at the headquarters of the Central Bank of Brazil, brings together international and national speakers, combining the perspective of academic research with cases and experiences of the corporate market and public agencies, in the use of disruptive technologies in internal control processes.

The WCARS takes place around the world, in an initiative of Prof. Dr. Miklos Vasarhelyi, who seeks to disseminate the work under development by his team of researchers and establish communication and collaboration with local institutions.
