- The interviews were very helpful, and the information shared will help the MADs team gain a deeper understanding of the problems and issues that firms are facing in the current world when working with ADA's and larger populations of data. This information will help the researchers to move forward and appropriately develop out the MADs framework.
- The research teams will be in touch to follow up, with the firms interviewed, if additional questions arise.
- The research teams do not anticipate conducting similar interviews for the other research projects.

MADs Project Update

- The team has been summarizing the feedback from the last seven interviews. The interviews have been very helpful for the research team in understanding how the MADs framework could be applied to the audit. For the October in person meeting, the team will be using the feedback from the interviews to update their first set of filters on the MADs framework.
